What is the MCYAB?

The Mill Creek Youth Advisory Board is an active group of high school students who represent their peers in the community for a one year commitment (June 2017 - June 2018). Commitment, reliability, enthusiasm, and leadership skills are strong characteristics of our members.

What does the MCYAB do?

- Members coordinate details for upcoming projects and events

- Serve as volunteers
