Catch Basin Stenciling

It is illegal to dump anything other than rain water down storm drains. One way to educate the community is to stencil storm drains. The message “DUMP NO WASTE – DRAINS TO STREAM” is painted next to a storm drain. This message will remind neighbors that anything spilled or dumped into the underground stormwater system flows directly into local streams and eventually into Puget Sound.
