## RESOLUTION NO. 2015-5

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MILL CREEK, WASHINGTON, AWARDING THE CONTRACT FOR THE 2015 MEDIAN AND DRAINAGE REPAIR PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the City of Mill Creek has properly issued invitations to bid for the 2015 Median and Drainage Repair Project; and

WHEREAS, the City received responsive and responsible bids from seven companies; and

WHEREAS, the City staff has evaluated the bid responses and presented that information to the City Council for review and consideration; and

WHEREAS, the cost to complete the work or improvement, including materials, supplies, and equipment required under the contract for the 2015 Median and Drainage Repair Project exceeds \$50,000; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager has recommended the City Council select Agostino Construction, Inc. as the lowest responsive and responsible bidder for the 2015 Median and Drainage Repair Project; and

WHEREAS, the City Council agrees with and adopts the findings and recommendations set forth in the Agenda Summary memorandum dated September 8, 2015; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that Agostino Construction, Inc. is the lowest responsive and responsible bidder on the project; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined it is in the public interest to award the contract for the project to Agostino Construction, Inc.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MILL CREEK, WASHINGTON, THAT:

Section 1. The contract for the 2015 Median and Drainage Repair Project is hereby awarded to Agostino Construction, Inc. as the lowest responsive and responsible bidder. The City Manager is authorized to execute the contract and such other documents as are pertinent to this award.

<u>Section 2.</u> The City Council finds that a need exists to award the bid in a timely manner to ensure the construction of the 2015 Median and Drainage Repair Project, and that this Resolution shall therefore be effective immediately upon adoption.
