## RESOLUTION NO. 84-17

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MILL CREEK, WASHINGTON, EXTENDING THE MORATORIUM UPON THE ISSUANCE OF ANY BUILDING PERMIT, OCCUPANCY PERMIT, BUSINESS LICENSE OR OTHER PERMIT OR LICENSE TO BUSINESSES AND/OR INDIVIDUALS OPERATING OR SEEKING TO OPERATE CERTAIN DESCRIBED BUSINESS ACTIVITIES.

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 84-4 of the City of Mill Creek, passed by the Mill Creek City Council on April 24, 1984, established a temporary moratorium upon the issuance of all business licenses and building or occupational permits for certain businesses defined in Resolution No. 84-5, passed by the Mill Creek City Council on May 2, 1984, pending formulation and adoption of land use regulations governing such businesses, and

WHEREAS, Section 4 of Resolution 84-4 states that the resolution shall expire on December 31, 1984 unless extended by action of the Mill Creek City Council, and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission has proceeded with due diligence in the consideration of this subject, and it is apparent that additional time is needed for the City Council to adequately consider and form regulations based upon the Planning Commission's recommendations, now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MILL CREEK, WASHINGTON, HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

The moratorium placed upon the issuance of Section 1. business licenses, building permits, occupational permits and all other permits and licenses for the businesses outlined and described in Resolution Nos. 84-4 and 84-5 is hereby reaffirmed and extended for a period of six months from the date of passage of this resolution, or until City Council adoption of comprehensive land use regulations governing such businesses.

This resolution shall expire on June 30, Section 2. 198 unless further extended by action of the City Council.
