## RESOLUTION NO. 85-32

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF MILL CREEK, WASHINGTON, ADOPTING A POLICY RESTRICTING USAGE OF THE TERMS "MILL CREEK" AND "MILL "AND DIRECTING CITY STAFF TO NOTIFY THE SNOHOMISH COUNTY COUNCIL AND THE DIRECTOR OF COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT FOR THE COUNTY OF THE CITY'S DESIRE TO RESTRICT THE NAME USAGE, AS WELL AS REQUEST THAT THE COUNTY ADOPT THE SAME OR A SIMILAR POLICY.

WHEREAS, the Mill Creek City Council finds that usage of
the terms "Mill Creek" or "Mill " as names for busi-
nesses or property developments may cause confusion as to the
location of the premises or property due to the numerous business
and property developments using the names "Mill Creek" or "Mill
", and
WHEREAS, the Mill Creek City Council finds that such
confusion caused by usage of the terms "Mill Creek" and "Mill
" can result in delay of emergency vehicle response
time; and
WHEREAS, the Mill Creek City Council finds that a policy
restricting usage of the terms "Mill Creek" and "Mill"
is in the interests of public health, safety and welfare, now,
therefore,
THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MILL CREEK, WASHINGTON,
HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:
Section 1. It is the policy of the City Council that
residential plats bearing the name "Mill Creek" or "Mill
be discouraged and shall not be approved if the City

Council finds that the proposed name may cause confusion as to location.

Section 2. The City staff is hereby instructed to notify Snohomish County Council and the Director of Community Development for the county of the City's desire to restrict usage of the terms "Mill Creek" and "Mill \_\_\_\_\_\_," for the reasons stated and encourage the county to adopt the same or similar policy.
