

RESOLUTION NO. 85-29

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING FUNDS TO BE BUDGETED FOR LIBRARY CONSTRUCTION IN FISCAL YEAR 1986.

WHEREAS, the City of Mill Creek does not now have a Library to provide service to its citizens, and

WHEREAS, the City Council, City of Mill Creek desires to have a Library for the use of its citizens and other citizens in South-East Snohomish County, and

WHEREAS, the City Council has designated the creation of a Library and the provision of Library service as its number one goal for the current year, and

WHEREAS, the City Council, City of Mill Creek, has previously set aside funds in the current (fiscal year 1985) operating budget in the amount of \$80,000.00 for the construction of a Library, and

WHEREAS, Sno-Isle Regional Library System is assisting the City of Mill Creek and has agreed to operate the Library if it were built, and

WHEREAS, the United States government and the State of Washington now have funds available through the Library

Services and Construction Act, Title II, for the construction of libraries, and

WHEREAS, the City of Mill Creek is desirous of applying for \$235,000. of such funds for the construction of the Mill Creek Public Library, and

WHEREAS, land for the construction of the Library is available and the City and its citizens have taken all steps possible to assure that land and funding is available, and

WHEREAS, citizens of the City of Mill Creek have established the Mill Creek Library Foundation to promote the formation of a public library and to assist in promoting the concept of library service and reading in the City of Mill Creek.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL, THE CITY OF MILL CREEK THAT, the City Council of the City of Mill Creek has already committed \$80,000. in the fiscal year 1985 budget towards the construction of the library and the City Council agrees to budget an amount equal to their normal library operating taxes in the 1986 budget. It is the intent of the Library Foundation to solicit funding to make up the difference between that amount normally reserved by the City of Mill Creek for library capital expenditures and the amount necessary to match funding to construct a library in 1986. In order to assure that sufficient revenues are available to meet the requirement for matching local monies, the City

Council of the City of Mill Creek does guarantee by this resolution that sufficient funds, in the amount of \$235,000., shall be provided for the purpose of matching a Washington State Library Grant to construct a public library in the City of Mill Creek in fiscal year 1986.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT, the City intends to provide funds for the professional operation of the library. The intent is to operate the library under a contract with the Sno-Isle Regional Library System; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT, the City does intend, if all funding is received, to build a library for the citizens of the City of Mill Creek and for the citizens of South-East Snohomish County.
