A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF MILL CREEK,
WASHINGTON, NAMING THE LIBRARY TO BE BUILT BY
THE CITY OF MILL CREEK AS "THE RALPH W. HAMMITT
AND WINNIFRED B. HAMMITT PUBLIC LIBRARY".

WHEREAS, a site located within the City of Mill Creek,
consisting of approximately two and one-half acres, has been
donated to the City for the purposes of constructing a library
facility and related improvements thereon, and

WHEREAS, it is fitting to recognize and memorialize the
persons on whose behalf such donation has been made, and

WHEREAS, the family of those persons in whose name the
property has been donated to the City have consented and
concurred that such recognition should occur by naming the
library facility in their honor, and

WHEREAS, the Library Board of Trustees of the City of
Mill Creek did meet and review the request of family, and by
formal motion at their meeting of February 24, 1986, did so
approve, and

WHEREAS, the Library Board of Trustees of the City of
Mill Creek approves of this action and recommends that the City
Council concur in said approval, now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MILL CREEK, WASHINGTON,
HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The library facility to be built by the
City of Mill Creek on that certain parcel of property donated by

the Hammitt family shall be named "The Ralph W. Hammitt and Winnifred B. Hammitt Public Library".

Section 2. An appropriate plaque or other delineation of the name of said facility shall be included as a part of the final constructed facility.
